Walk alongside refugees rebuilding their lives in Canada...



When Linda received a letter from her cousin in the Netherlands about helping an Eritrean refugee, Kidane, settle in Canada, she set the idea aside. That sounded like a lot of effort!

We can so easily live in our insulated bubbles and ignore the need around us. We were amazed at how God answered our prayers!"
