A Story to Share: Little Things, Big Changes

We may forget the importance of little things: clean, safe water; a toilet; availability of fresh fruits and vegetables; education.

Shilpi, a young mother in Bangladesh, struggled to care for her children. They were often sick. But she also felt other challenges. Shilpi and her family were often excluded from the community and friends didn't want to visit.

When Shilpi joined a World Renew women's group, things started to change. The group shared the importance of sanitation and hygiene. And, Shilpi recognized that she had to make it a priority to build a latrine on her property. Without a latrine, the family used a small area of their property as a toilet; the same area where their chickens and ducks scratched and flies buzzed incessantly.

It seems like a small thing, but when Shilpi finally had enough money to build a latrine, her family's health improved. For the first time the family had a private space, free from flies and animals. More than that, their water well was protected from becoming tainted by fecal matter.

Women's groups around the world are helping mothers care for their families. Mothers are encouraged to breastfeed their infants as long as they can. They also learn which foods are best for infants and toddlers and how to protect their children against disease.

This Sunday, we celebrate mothers. Our support for mothers during pregnancy and for the first 5 years of a child's life transforms communities.

Today 810 women will die from causes related to pregnancy and childbirth.

Here are just a few statistics to help you understand the breadth of the issue:

- 94% of deaths as a result of pregnancy and childbirth occur in low-resource settings.
- Pregnant girls
 (10-14) are at highrisk to experience complications.
- In 2021, conflict, climate crisis and COVID-19 threaten the lives of mothers and their children.
